As we continue to navigate the political battle, economic instability, and brutal gang violence in Haiti, the mission of Haiti Teen Challenge (HTC) is more relevant and urgent than ever. We must expand and accelerate efforts to make HTC accessible to more young men and women, catalyze the development and deployment of solutions to our graduates, strengthen community engagement, and intentionally advance the Gospel.

Amid all the chaos, however, I find great hope knowing there is something that is working in the country. At HTC, we are on target with the disciple-making mission of "building Godly leaders of integrity." We have found that the Gospel works through taking lives wasted by sin and the world's influence and transforming them. We will continue to make disciples, knowing it works no matter the situation.

As you read this report, you will see that despite the challenges and constraints, it has been a very productive year for HTC–all of which would not have been possible without YOU. Your prayers and financial support enabled us to reach 3+ million people with the Gospel, train over 4,000 church leaders, and save thousands for God's glory. Many made public confessions through water baptism, and our ministry served as a hub for distributing thousands of Creole Bibles. Because of you, we were able to deliver thousands of pounds of food and supplies to natural disaster victims.

Moving forward, we will continue to depend on the supernatural power of the Gospel and your partnership as we raise an army of next-generation godly leaders to impact the nation.

HTC is the only residential recovery program in Haiti where troubled young men and women are transformed by Christ and equipped to be catalysts for change in their nation.

Throughout HTC's 18-month program, students break the cycle of addiction and dependencies, all while reading and studying the word of God and serving the community.

Each student's skills, abilities, and gifts are identified, and one-on-one mentoring equips students to apply biblical principles to their daily lives. After graduation, scholarships are secured for schooling in a vocation/trade, and students are guided in finding jobs or internships.

With the support of HTC mentors, resources, and the local church, students can confidently sustain their new life.

# ...it is WORKING

My past was dark and grim. At a young age, alcohol and sex controlled my life and completely destroyed it. I always felt like I had no future, and my parents loathed my behavior. God, however, in His amazing love, had a different plan for me.

Seeing the life I was living, a friend of mine reached out and spoke to me about Haiti Teen Challenge. He told me how HTC's mission was to transform the lives of troubled young men and women like myself by sharing the gospel of truth and equipping them with skills to help them live a better life away from addiction. I was hopeful that maybe there was still a chance for me; maybe God didn't forget me after all. I wanted change and a new beginning for my life, so I enrolled in the program.

As soon as I set foot at HTC, the leaders of the men's center quickly noticed my strong sense of leadership. However, blinded by my addictions, those beginning months in the program were anything but fun. This kept me from moving in the right direction, and for a while I was my own obstacle. The leaders at HTC Men's Center understood my struggle. They provided me with the spiritual, social, and intellectual support I needed to move forward. Thanks to God and their dedication, my life was transformed.

After graduating from HTC, I was given a scholarship and completed a degree in IT. Now, I have returned to my community, and I can humbly say that I am one of its most influential leaders. Thanks to all that I learned, I started an organization offering leadership, computer, personal development, and English language courses to young people in my area.

Bible teachings also occupy a prominent place in my ministry. Every Sunday, in addition to streaming RVC services for the members of my community, I lead small group Bible studies to equip them with solid knowledge of the word of God.

I would not be doing this if not for God and the wonderful ministry of Haiti Teen Challenge.

While we have partnered with other non-profit organizations, HTC and RVC are at the top of our list due to their governance, accountability, organizational integrity, and the significant impact they continue to


